## **PURPOSE:**

Purpose is to provide the public with an overview of the Fire District's plan to transition from atlarge to by-division elections and adoption of a boundary map pursuant to the California Voting Rights Act (CVRA) and associated statutes, and review draft maps with the proposed boundary lines.
