1. DISCUSSION OF AB 557 (HART) – EMERGENCY REMOTE MEETINGS
Purpose is for the Legislative Committee to discuss California Special District's request for support of Assembly Bill 557 related to emergency remote meeting procedures under the Ralph M. Brown Act and consider a letter of support.

President DeMonaco provided a summary of the bill that proposes to extend the provisions of Assembly Bill 361 to conduct remote meetings during emergencies and requires approval of a resolution by the legislative body recognizing the continued emergency every 45 days.

President DeMonaco asked if there was Public comment.

The Legislative Committee agreed to support California Special Districts Association's (CSDA) request for a letter of support of Assembly Bill 557 related to emergency remote meeting procedures under the Ralph M. Brown Act and authorized staff to submit the letter of support to CSDA.
